### **From the Captain's Lady, Louetta Hollyfield**

Hello Lady Knights,  
I would like to thank all of you who came to our August meeting and helped to support the Shelter for Domestic Violence by contributing women's hygiene products. I thought you might be interested on how many items we did collect. The total came to 381. WOW!

You ladies are wonderful and know that you are helping someone else who is going through a rough time. Once again THANK YOU!

I wanted to remind all of you about our meeting on September 20th. We will be having Cindy Rovai come in and show us the "LEBED METHOD" it is a therapeutic movement and dance exercise focusing on healing. I think it will be a fun evening so please plan on attending, we need your support.

I had a few requests for last month's lasagna recipe:

#### **CROCKPOT LASAGNA**

- 1 pound ground beef
- ½ cup diced onion
- 1 teaspoon minced garlic
- 1 (24 ounce) jar spaghetti sauce
- ½ cup water
- 1(15 ounce) container cottage cheese
- 2 cups mozzarella cheese
- ¼ cup grated Parmesan cheese
- 1 whole egg
- 2 Tablespoons fresh parsley or 2 teaspoons dried parsley
- 6 UNCOOKED lasagna noodles

In a large skillet brown beef and onion. Add garlic and cook for one minute. Drain

Add spaghetti sauce and water and simmer for 5 minutes. Mix cottage cheese, 1/12 cups mozzarella, 2 Tablespoon Parmesan cheese, egg and parsley.

Pour 1 cup spaghetti meat sauce into a 4-6 quart crock pot. Place half of the noodles and half of the cottage cheese mixture on top of the sauce. Cover with 2 cups meat sauce. Top with remaining noodles ( if the noodles do not fit exactly break them to fit) and cheese mixture and meat sauce.

Cook on low for 4-5 hours or until noodles are soft. I found that it did not take quite that long so be sure to check your crock pot.

Sprinkle with ½ cup of mozzarella cheese and remaining parmesan.

Cover with the lid to melt the cheese and let it sit for 10 minutes before serving.

Do not overcook or try to speed up the process by cooking it on high. Enjoy!
